

Privacy Notice pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679

This privacy notice is provided pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 concerning the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data, as well as the free movement of such data (hereinafter referred to as the **"Regulation"** or **"GDPR"**), and the current privacy regulations in force.

We hereby inform you that the data collected through the website <u>https://bitrock.it/</u> (including any linked third-level domains), managed by **Bitrock S.r.I.** as an independent Data Controller (hereinafter referred to as the **"Controller"**), will be processed in compliance with the principles outlined in Article 5 of the Regulation and ensuring the lawfulness of the processing as stated in Article 6 of the same Regulation.

In relation to the above, we therefore inform you of the following:

This information is not collected to be associated with identified individuals. Such data is used solely to obtain anonymous statistical information about the use of the site and to verify its correct functioning. 4. Scope of communication of personal data

5. Methods of data processing

We also inform you that your Personal Data will be processed in accordance with the methods outlined in the Regulation, which stipulate, among other things, that the data must:

- be accurate and, where necessary, kept up to date;
- be relevant, complete, and not excessive in relation to the purposes of the processing;
- be stored in a form that allows the identification of the data subject for no longer than is necessary for the purposes for which the data is collected or subsequently processed;
- be processed in accordance with standardized procedures established by a single supervisory authority ("Lead Authority"), identified with reference to the State where the Data Controller has its main establishment.

Furthermore, the Controller's business processes ensure the confidentiality and security of the information and its storage in compliance with legislative requirements and the necessary security measures.
